A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VERO BEACH, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING THE VERO BEACH ARTS DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, over 90 years ago, the City of Vero Beach began building its first business and arts district in the Downtown; and

WHEREAS, Downtown Vero Beach is now home to more than 100 artists and artisans, making it a regional artistic hub of Indian River County; and

WHEREAS, this regional artistic hub includes 12 art galleries and studios, as well as museums and a multitude of businesses supporting the arts through dance, theater and the culinary arts; and

WHEREAS, Downtown Vero Beach is the site of historic City structures with murals depicting the City’s heritage; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Vero Beach finds that recognizing the Vero Beach Arts District will promote and help facilitate the efforts of Main Street, the Cultural Council of Indian River County, and the many artists and artisans who operate within Historic Downtown Vero Beach to continue and expand their contributions to the viability and creative economy of the City of Vero Beach;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VERO BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1.

The area graphically depicted on Exhibit “A,” attached and incorporated herein, is hereby recognized as the “Vero Beach Arts District.”

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.






